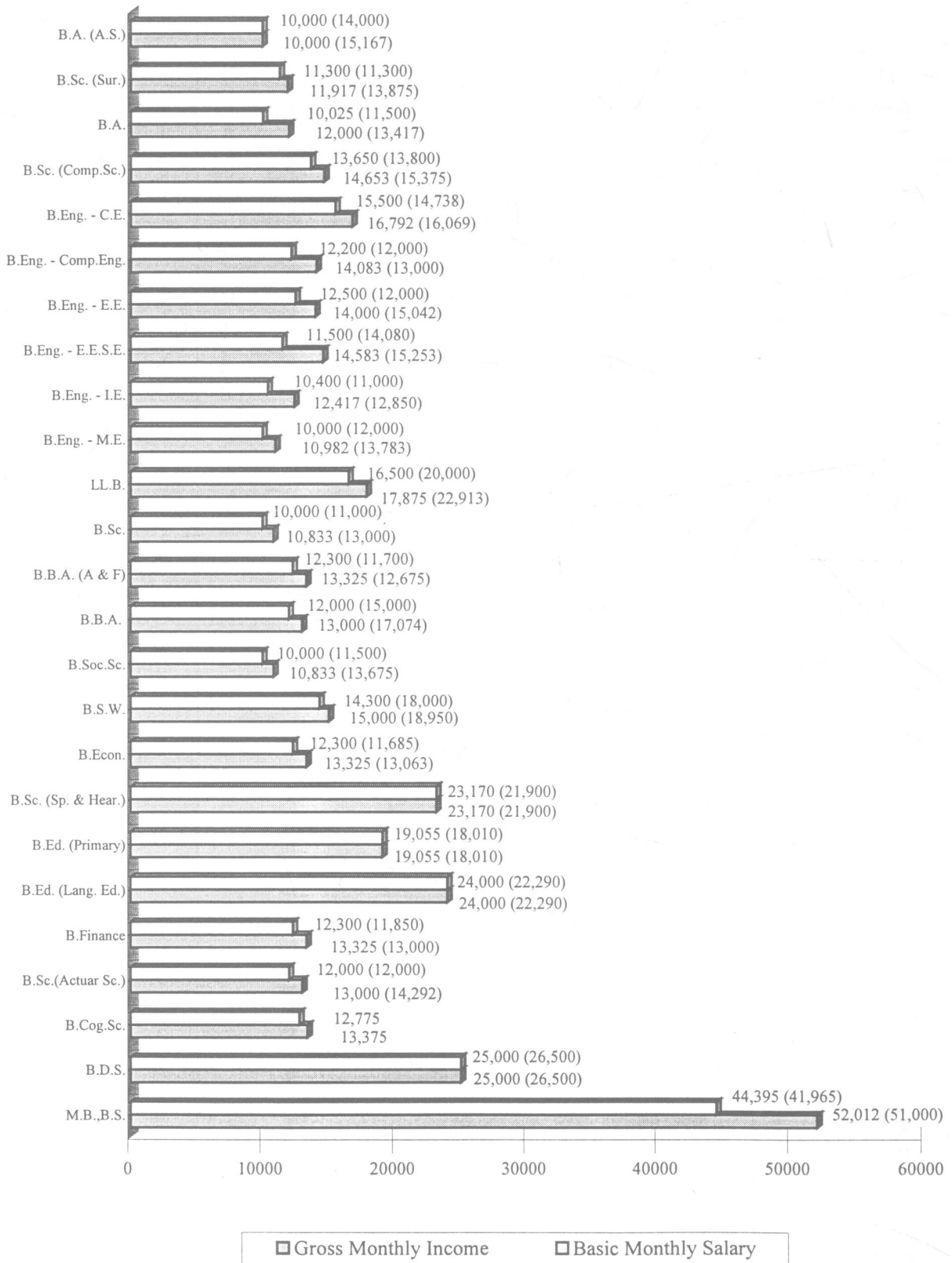

(1998 BACHELOR'S DEGREE)**

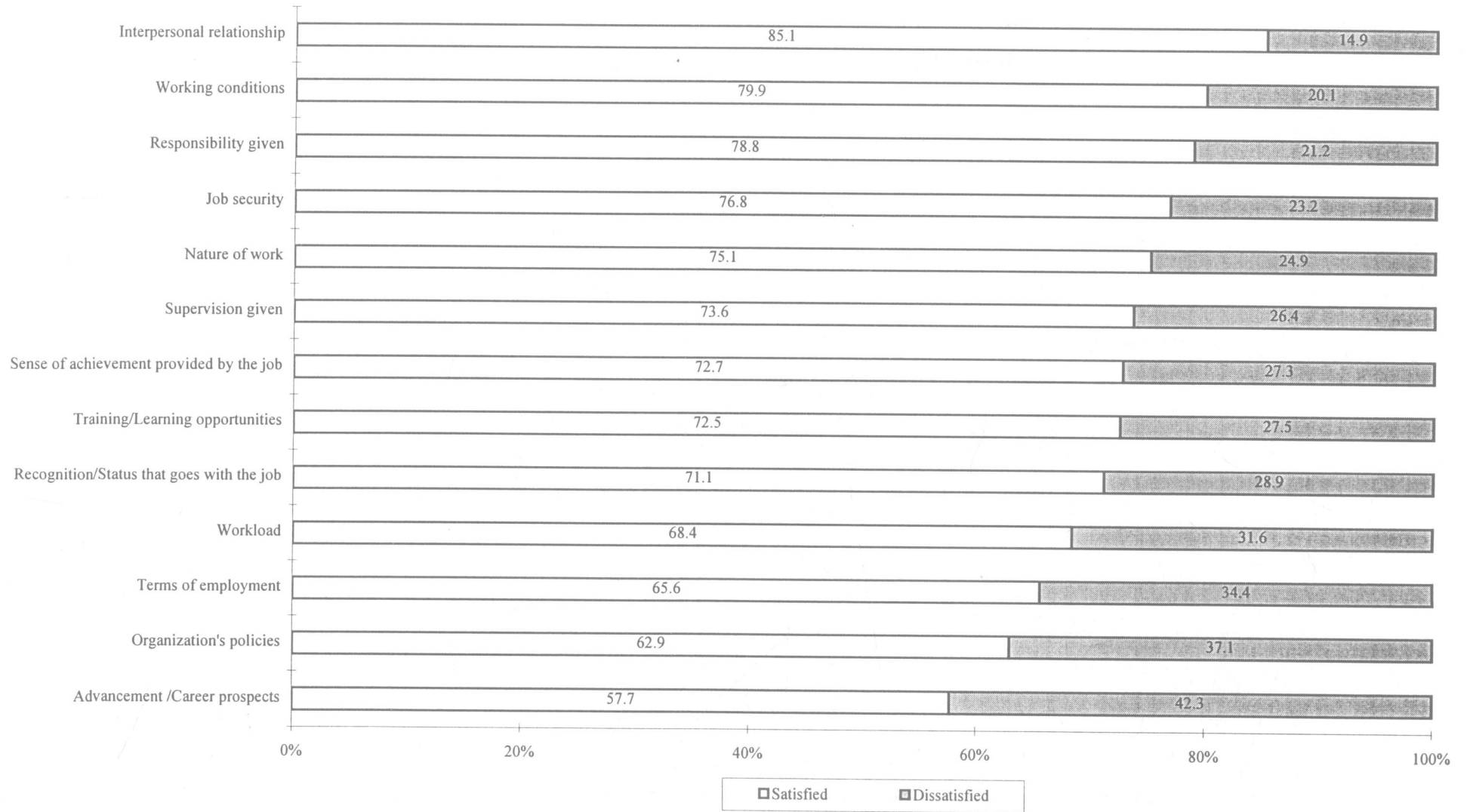

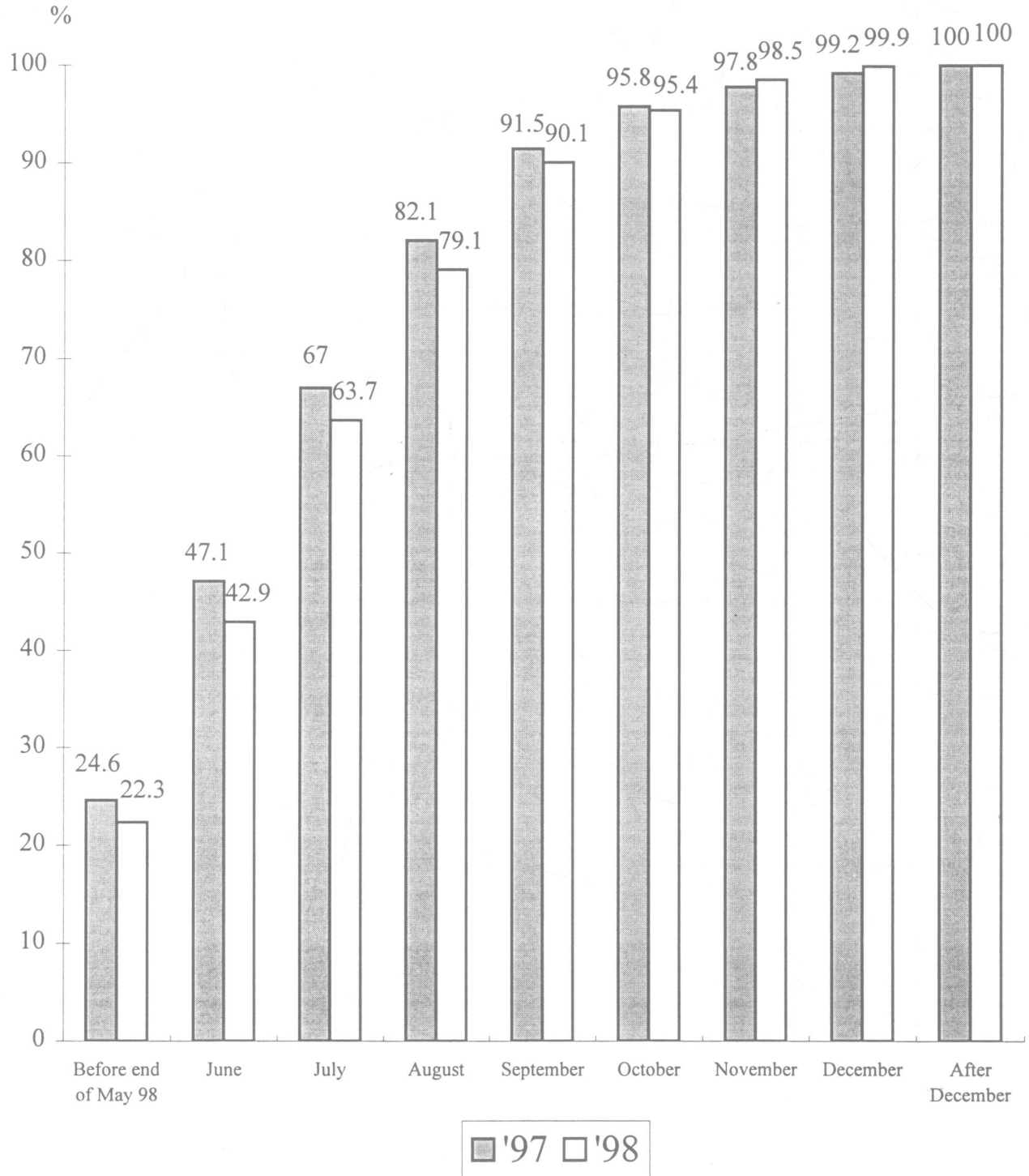
